

FEDERAL ACQUISITION REGULATION (FAR) & DEFENSE FEDERAL ACQUISITION REGULATION (DFAR) FLOWDOWN PROVISIONS FOR SUBCONTRACTS OR PURCHASE ORDERS UNDER A US DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE PRIME CONTRACT

1. INCORPORATION OF FAR/DFAR CLAUSES

In accordance with FAR 52.252-1 and 52.252-2, the FAR and DFARS clauses referenced below are incorporated herein by reference, with the same force and effect as if they were given in full text, and are applicable, including any notes following the clause citation, to this Contract. If the date or substance of any of the clauses listed below is different from the date or substance of the clause actually incorporated in the Prime Contract referenced by number herein, the date or substance of the clause incorporated by said Prime Contract shall apply instead.

When a clause uses a word or term that is defined in the FAR or DFARS, the word or term shall have the same meaning as in the definition in FAR 2.101, DFARS 202.101 in effect on the date of this Contract unless (i) a different definition is expressly set forth in this Contract; or (ii) the part, subpart, or section of the FAR, DFARS or supplement where the clause is prescribed provides a different meaning; or (iii) the word or term is defined in FAR Part 31, for use in the cost principles and procedures.

If applicable, class deviations found at https://www.acq.osd.mil/dpap/dars/class deviations.html shall take precedence over the relevant flow down. If corresponding FAR and DFARS clauses are referenced, DFARS has first precedence, followed by the FAR.

The Contracts Disputes Act shall have no application to this Contract, and nothing in this Contract grants Seller a direct claim or cause of action against the U.S. Government. Any reference to a "Disputes" clause shall mean the "Disputes" clause of this Contract. Seller shall include in each lower-tier subcontract the appropriate flow down clauses as required by the FAR and DFARS Supplement clauses included in this Contract.

2. GOVERNMENT SUBCONTRACT

- (a) This Contract is entered into by SAPA Transmission and Seller in support of a U.S. Department of Defense (DoD) contract.
- (b) As used in the FAR and DFARS clauses referenced below and otherwise in this Contract:
 - 1. "Commercial product" means any such product as defined in FAR 2.101. or DFARS 202.101.
 - 2. "Commercial service" means any such service as defined in FAR 2.101.
 - 3. "Commercially available off-the-shelf (COTS) item" means a COTS item as defined in FAR 2.101.
 - 4. "Contract" means this contract.
 - 5. "Contracting Officer" shall mean the U.S. Government Contracting Officer for the prime contract under which this Contract/Subcontract is entered.
 - 6. "Contractor" and "Offeror" means the Seller, which is the party identified on the face of the Contract with whom SAPA Transmission, Inc. is contracting, acting as the immediate subcontractor to SAPA Transmission.
 - 7. "Prime Contract" means the contract between SAPA Transmission and the DoD or between SAPA Transmission and its higher-tier contractor who has a contract with the DoD.
 - 8. "Subcontract" means any contract placed by Seller or lower-tier subcontractors under this Contract.
- (c) If any of the following clauses do not apply to this Subcontract/Purchase Order, as defined in the respective FAR or DFARS provision, such clauses are considered to be self-deleting. Seller shall incorporate and require that each lower tier contractor supporting this Purchase Order incorporate all applicable regulations in accordance with the flow down requirements specified in such clauses.

3. NOTES

- (a) The following notes apply to the clauses incorporated by reference below only when specified in the parenthetical phrase following the clause title and date.
 - 1. Substitute "SAPA Transmission" for "Government" or "United States" throughout this clause.
 - 2. Substitute "SAPA Transmission Procurement Representative" for "Contracting Officer", "Administrative Contracting Officer", and "ACO" throughout this clause.
 - 3. Insert "and SAPA Transmission" after "Government" throughout this clause.
 - 4. Insert "or SAPA Transmission" after "Government" throughout this clause.
 - 5. Communication/notification required under this clause from/to Seller to/from the Contracting Officer shall be through SAPA Transmission.
 - 6. Insert "and SAPA Transmission" after "Contracting Officer", throughout the clause.
 - 7. Insert "or SAPA Transmission Procurement Representative" after "Contracting Officer", throughout the clause.
 - 8. If Seller is an international contractor, this clause applies to this Contract only if Work under the Contract will be performed in the United States or Contractor is recruiting employees in the United States to Work on the Contract.

4. AMENDMENTS REQUIRED BY PRIME CONTRACT

Seller agrees that upon the request of SAPA Transmission it will negotiate in good faith with SAPA Transmission relative to amendments to this Contract to incorporate additional provisions herein or to change provisions hereof, as SAPA Transmission may reasonably deem necessary in order to comply with the provisions of the applicable Prime Contract or with the provisions of amendments to such Prime Contract. If any such amendment to this Contract causes an increase or decrease in the cost of, or the time required for, performance of any part of the Work under this Contract, an equitable adjustment shall be made.







5. PRESERVATION OF THE GOVERNMENT'S RIGHTS

If SAPA Transmission furnishes designs, drawings, special tooling, equipment, engineering data, or other technical or proprietary information (Furnished Items) which the U.S. Government owns or has the right to authorize the use of, nothing herein shall be construed to mean that SAPA Transmission, acting on its own behalf, may modify or limit any rights the Government may have to authorize Seller's use of such Furnished Items in support of other U.S. Government prime contracts.
